CONFERENCE REGISTRATION

You must register and collect your name badge for the conference prior to joining your tour. AHISA's registration desk will be located in the Parkside Foyer, Level 2 of the ICC Sydney.

You will be issued with your lanyard and advised where to meet for your respective tour.

The registration desk will be open from 8.30am on Monday 8 April, and we strongly encourage you to register early to avoid congestion closer to the tours starting.

Guided transfers by foot to and from UTS will operate from the ICC Sydney main foyer on Monday, 8th of April, departing 1.50pm and arriving back by at approximately 4.45pm.

1.45pm	Meet just outside the ICC Sydney Main Entrance located at Iron Wharf Place.
2.00pm	Delegates meet UTS Student Ambassadors outside ICC Sydney (Iron Wharf Place). Ambassadors will guide the delegates to UTS, touring past some points of interest along the way.
2.20pm	Arrive at the University of Technology Sydney UTS is a leader in sustainability, creativity, and innovation with cutting edge research and facilities, supporting students to tackle the biggest challenges of our time. Come and meet with leaders to explore for how universities can work with high schools to create new possibilities. Afternoon tea and meeting with faculty leaders from UTS
